Applications are due by September 1st for visits to occur in the spring semester and February 1st for visits to occur in the fall semester. (We generally do not host visitors in the summer months.) A faculty committee will review requests to visit the department twice yearly (in early October and early March) and will communicate decisions to applicants at those times.

Typically, the department is able to offer shared office space, the use of a computer and printer, and library privileges. We also encourage visitors to participate in the life of the department by sharing research, visiting classes and/or delivering a talk.
